

DOFFING (TAKING OFF) PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)
 DROPLET & CONTACT AND AIRBORNE PRECAUTIONS WITH AGMPs (AEROSOL-GENERATING MEDICAL PROCEDURES)


PREPARE

Additional moments of hand hygiene can be added to doffing procedure if contamination is suspected at any time


<input type="checkbox"/>	Engage with peer support to ensure PPE is taken off correctly using the checklist
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ensure you have completed all the tasks necessary inside the patients room before doffing any PPE
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ensure you have easy access to the required waste bins (i.e. no-touch waste bin and laundry bin)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Make sure you complete doffing slowly and be mindful of contamination

INSIDE THE ROOM (DO THE FOLLOWING STEPS BEFORE LEAVING THE PATIENT ROOM)


1 DOFF/TAKE OFF GLOVES

	<input type="checkbox"/>	With a gloved hand, grasp the outside edge near your wrist or palm area of the other gloved hand and peel it away (glove to glove)
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Rolling the glove inside out, hold onto the removed glove with the remaining gloved hand
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Slide fingers of ungloved hand under remaining glove at wrist and peel off second glove over first glove (skin to skin)
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Gently discard gloves into the no-touch waste bin
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Your hands are still technically clean at this point. If you think you have contaminated them during glove removal, perform hand hygiene


2 PERFORM HAND HYGIENE

	<input type="checkbox"/>	Perform hand hygiene for 20 seconds, cleaning all surfaces of hands and wrists
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Use alcohol based handrub (ABHR) or soap and water.
	<input type="checkbox"/>	If hands are soiled, use soap and water.

3 DOFF/TAKE OFF GOWN

	<input type="checkbox"/>	Untie gown at the back of the neck and waist, ensuring sleeves don't contact your body when reaching for ties
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Grasp the inside of the gown at the back of the shoulder and gently pull the gown down over the arms
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Turn the gown inside out during removal and slowly fold or roll the gown into a bundle
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Gently discard the gown into the designated laundry bin (reusable gowns) or no-touch waste bin (disposable gowns)

4 PERFORM HAND HYGIENE

	<input type="checkbox"/>	Perform hand hygiene for 20 seconds, cleaning all surfaces of hands and wrists
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Use alcohol based handrub (ABHR) or soap and water.
	<input type="checkbox"/>	If hands are soiled, use soap and water.


5 EXIT PATIENT ROOM

DOFFING PPE – Continued


DROPLET & CONTACT AND AIRBORNE PRECAUTIONS WITH AGMPs (AEROSOL-GENERATING MEDICAL PROCEDURES)

OUTSIDE THE ROOM (DO THE FOLLOWING STEPS OUTSIDE THE PATIENT ROOM OR INSIDE ANTE ROOM)


6 DOFF/TAKE OFF EYE PROTECTION (GOGGLES OR FACE SHIELD)

	<input type="checkbox"/>	Being careful not to touch the front of your goggles or face shield, remove eye protection from the back by lifting head band, ear pieces or undoing ties
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Bend forward slightly and carefully pull goggle or face shield away from the face
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Put reusable items in appropriate area for cleaning
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Gently discard any single-use items into the no-touch waste bin


7 PERFORM HAND HYGIENE

	<input type="checkbox"/>	Perform hand hygiene for 20 seconds, cleaning all surfaces of hands and wrists
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Use alcohol based handrub (ABHR) or soap and water.
	<input type="checkbox"/>	If hands are soiled, use soap and water.

8 DOFF/TAKE OFF MASK

	SURGICAL OR PROC. MASK	<input type="checkbox"/>	Remove surgical / procedure mask without touching the front of the mask
		<input type="checkbox"/>	Bending forward slightly, undo mask ties or grasp mask loops behind ears and pull away from face
		<input type="checkbox"/>	Gently discard mask into the no-touch waste bin
	N95 MASK	<input type="checkbox"/>	Grasp bottom strap from behind your head and pull forward over your head, hang onto strap
		<input type="checkbox"/>	Bending forward slightly, grasp the top strap behind your head and pull forward over your head
		<input type="checkbox"/>	Allow mask to fall away from your face
		<input type="checkbox"/>	Gently discard N95 mask into the no-touch waste bin


9 PERFORM HAND HYGIENE

	<input type="checkbox"/>	Perform hand hygiene for 20 seconds, cleaning all surfaces of hands and wrists
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Use alcohol based handrub (ABHR) or soap and water.
	<input type="checkbox"/>	If hands are soiled, use soap and water.

10 EXIT ANTE ROOM

IF NO ANTE-ROOM AVAILABLE, THE FOLLOWING STEPS MAY OCCUR FURTHER FROM THE PATIENT ROOM

CLEANING & DISENFECTING OF REUSABLE EYE PROTECTION

	<input type="checkbox"/>	Clean visibly soiled areas and equipment with a hospital grade disinfectant to remove any debris (i.e. Cavi-Wipes, Accell Prevention Wipes, Bleach wipes, etc.)
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Using a second wipe, clean all surfaces ensuring they remain wet for 3 minutes
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Place reusable eye protection on a clean surface to dry
	<input type="checkbox"/>	Exit the anteroom
