This course highlights the importance of the Point of Care Risk Assessment and teaches the practices that will help protect patients, health care providers and the family/visitors.	8300	1 hr
3 Infection Prevention and Control Practices for Health Care Personnel Not Involved in Direct Clinical Care This module teaches the basic principles of infection control within the healthcare system, including hand hygiene, sharps management, blood and body fluid exposure and clean-up, proper use of personal protective equipment, and additional precautions.	8301	1 hr
