

COVID-19: MANAGEMENT OF CONTACT TRACING WHEN A STAFF TESTS POSITIVE (GUIDELINE)

What's New?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The purpose of this guideline is to provide direction and clarity with management of contact tracing when a staff (includes medical) tests positive for COVID-19. This guideline is applicable for all operation/medical dyads (“OPs dyads”) and managers at BCCH and BCWH who are managing a staff member symptomatic for COVID-19 and subsequently test positive for the virus.
Why?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The purpose of this document is to support OPs Dyad’s understanding of the main algorithm, ‘Management of C&W COVID Positive Staff and Contact Tracing, one’s own role and responsibilities within it.
