<b>What's New?</b>	<p>Clarification on the use of filters on resuscitation devices:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• T-piece does not require a HEPA filter</li> <li>• Other resuscitation devices and ventilators will use HEPA filters</li> </ul> <p>Clarification on use of PPE for transport:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Aligned with <a href="#">COVID 19: Patient Transfer/Transport Procedure</a></li> </ul>
<b>Why?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure alignment with campus-wide PPE preservation measures, ensure equipment is used appropriately and safely</li> </ul>
<b>How does this affect my practice?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When infants of COVID-19 positive, Suspect/PUI or contact are transferred to NICU following resuscitation, PPE will be preserved and move with the patient environment.</li> <li>• A HEPA filter will not be added to the T-piece</li> </ul>
