## COVID-19: PPE Use - Application of PPE Prioritization Framework April 3, 2020

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What's New?	The COVID-19: Application of PPE Prioritization Framework Policy has been revised.
Why the Change?	<ul> <li>Explain the dual goals of protecting staff and protecting PPE supply.</li> <li>Clarify PPE use differences for HCPs and staff who provide Direct Patient Care, those who provide no Direct Patient Care and those who enter Patient Environment but perform no Direct Patient Care</li> <li>Provide clear direction on Point of Care Risk Assessment for patient care area and each patient interaction to guide PPE use and when to change PPE.</li> </ul>
How does this affect my practice?	<ul> <li>Read the revised policy on ePOPS <u>COVID-19</u>: <u>PPE Use - Application Of PPE Emergency Prioritization Policy</u> or access the updated policy on <u>ePOPS</u> under the Routine and Additional Precautions section and refer to the Personal Protective Equipment resources.</li> <li>Follow all PPE use and limiting use requirements as directed for your role.</li> </ul>
