What's New?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Describes patient flow from arrival to hospital to discharge home when stable • Applicable for gyne (Wednesday) and CARE (Friday) surgical patients with COVID-19 <p>BCWH Surgical Screening Algorithm</p>
Why?	Approved pathways of travel for BCWH surgical gyne and CARE patients with COVID-19. Incorporates points of hand hygiene for RN and patient, when patient needs to don a mask, when RN dons PPE, patient escort into OR room and recovery rooms and instructions for discharge home.
How does this affect my practice?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff involved with gyne and CARE surgical patients to be informed of this arrival to discharge patient pathway.
