What's New?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Describes patient flow from arrival to hospital to transfer to designated post-partum location • Applicable for scheduled obstetrical surgical patients with COVID-19 BCWH Surgical Screening Algorithm
Why?	Approved pathways of travel for BCWH obstetrical surgical patients with COVID-19. Incorporates points of hand hygiene for RN and patient, when patient needs to don a mask, when RN dons PPE, patient escort into designated OR room and designated recovery room, and transfer to designated post-partum location.
