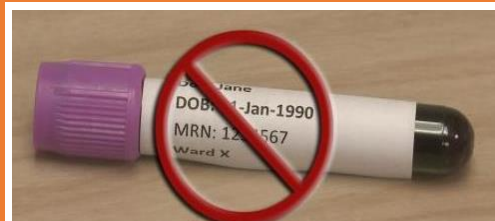


## ACCEPTABLE LABELS FOR GROUP AND SCREEN COLLECTION: SUNQUEST COLLECT WORKFLOW

### OVERVIEW

- ▶ Sunquest Collect labels and the C&W Group & Screen (hand label) are the only acceptable labels for Group and Screen Samples
- ▶ **DO NOT** use Cerner labels for Group & Screen samples if the Sunquest Collect labels fail to print



### KEY PRINCIPLES

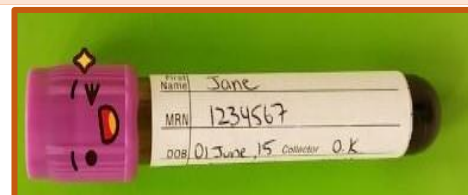
- ▶ Patient Safety is improved when using specific labels as it minimizes potential risk of mislabeled samples; these include Sunquest Collect labels or C&W Group and Screen Labels
- ▶ Cerner labels and Sunquest labels are NOT interchangeable
  - ▶ Sunquest labels are considered safe because they are “print-on-demand” labels and part of the electronic patient identification system; Cerner labels are readily available for “general” use and therefore not accepted for Group & Screen samples

### If Sunquest labels FAIL TO PRINT

1. **HAND LABEL** using the C&W group & screen sample label



2. **DO NOT** use Cerner labels; the sample will be rejected!
