

## CST CERNER ALERTS

### STANDARDIZATION – DOCUMENTATION

OVERVIEW

#### At Go-Live


- ▶ Prior to go-live many alerts from CW Cerner will be inputted (called cutover) into CST Cerner
- ▶ These include Disease, Process and Violence Alerts




### KEY PRINCIPLES

- Examples of some alerts before and after transition from CW Cerner to CST Cerner:
  - ▶ Canuck Place -> Canuck Place
  - ▶ Care Plan -> Special Care Plan
  - ▶ Over Age Approval -> Special Care Plan
  - ▶ Safety and VIP/Visitor Restriction -> History of Violence
- Upon patient admission/appointment:
  - ▶ Conduct appropriate screening (e.g. Violence Risk screen)
  - ▶ If alert was cutover, request old chart/review CW Cerner to look for supporting documents to determine if:
    - Current paper document needs to be part of chartlet (to be scanned upon discharge) **OR**
    - A current care plan needs to be documented/updated directly in CST Cerner
  - ▶ Verify most appropriate alert is present (e.g. History of Violence to Violence Risk if active)

**When reviewing the old chart (ex. History of Violence) please verify and confirm if any VIP alerts/Visitor restrictions need to be entered into CST Cerner**
