

Direct Maternal Admission to BCW Postpartum Unit

HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Select the correct encounter type: **inpatient encounter** in the **BCW postpartum unit (e.g. FIR)** location
- ▶ If the patient delivered at a non-CST Cerner site, 1) complete the **OB Triage & Assessment PowerForm**, 2) **open a pregnancy** and 3) **back enter the delivery information in iView** (this information flows to reports, dynamic documentation and to the postpartum liaison)
- ▶ If the patient delivered at a live CST-Cerner site 1) complete the **OB Triage & Assessment PowerForm**, and 2) **reopen the last active pregnancy** (if required)
- ▶ Document postpartum-specific assessments in the OB Postpartum band
- ▶ Document head to toe assessments in the OB Systems Assessment band

OB triage & assessment powerform

If the patient arrives directly to BCW postpartum (from another hospital), postpartum nurses will document in the OB Triage & Assessment PowerForm.

If the patient was seen in the BCW UCC prior to transfer the postpartum ward, postpartum nurses do not need to document in the OB Triage & Assessment PowerForm, because the UCC nurses will have already charted in that Powerform. However, information documented in that Powerform can be viewed by navigating to Form Browser → right clicking the Powerform and selecting view.

Postpartum nurses can document in this PowerForm via the OB tracking shell:

Navigate through each section in the PowerForm and enter information based on data in the chart and assessment findings on arrival.

Information charted in this PowerForm flows to other areas of the chart, such as the OB tracking shell and the liaison forms. This is why it is important to document key prenatal investigations and labs within this PowerForm, if not already completed.

Once documentation is complete, click the green check mark in the top left corner to sign (not save).

If modification of data previously entered is needed or new data needs to be added to this PowerForm, this can be done:

Navigate to Form Browser in the blue table of contents → right click the PowerForm → select modify → document mods/add new info as needed. Click the green check mark to sign when documentation complete

View documentation

OB Postpartum Band for postpartum assessments:

- Including vital signs, documented in the MEOWs section

OB Systems Assessment Band for head to toe assessments

If additional documentation cannot be adequately captured in IView:

Click the add+ button next to Documentation on the table of contents → create a nursing narrative note
After selecting the sign/submit button, modify the nursing note **title** to specify the nature of the note:

P Sign/Submit Note

*Type: Nursing Narrative Note Note Type List Filter: All

*Author: TestMAT, Nurse-OB2 Title: Admission note

Back enter the delivery documentation in IView

If the patient delivered at a non-CST Cerner site, nursing will need to back enter the 1) delivery date/time, 2) delivery type, and 3) neonate outcome. This information flows to other parts of the patient chart, and will allow the pregnancy to be closed seamlessly upon patient discharge.

Navigate to iView:


Labour & Delivery band → Delivery information nursing section → open a dynamic group for the baby (baby A), and fill in the delivery date/time

→ Delivery information provider section → delivery type (e.g. vaginal)

Newborn Delivery Data band → Initial newborn information section → document neonate outcome (e.g. live birth)

*Clinician's will need to refer to the chartlet for this information (paper partogram and labour & birth summary)


If the patient delivered at a live CST Cerner site, confirm the patient has an open pregnancy. If the patient does not have an open pregnancy, please reopen the last active pregnancy (see screenshots).
