
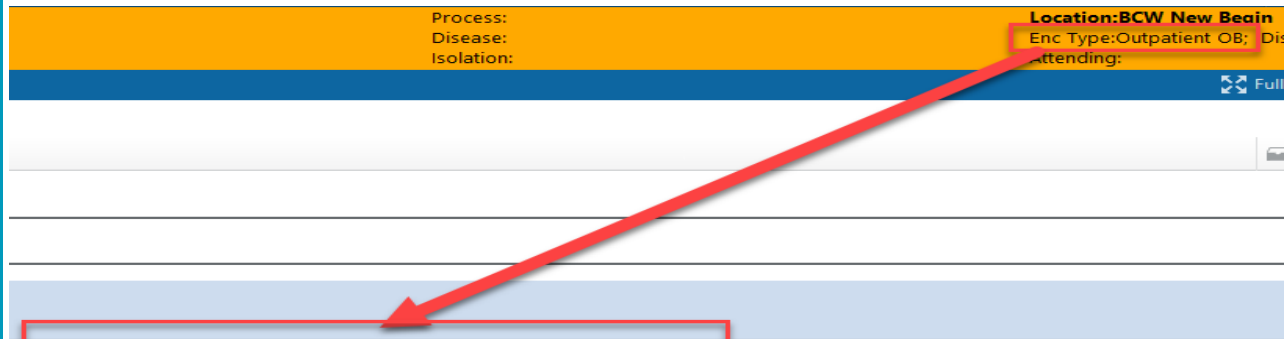


Prenatal Cards: BCW Maternity Ambulatory Program

- ▶ A prenatal card will generate when:
 - 1) The patient is in an **outpatient OB encounter type**, and
 - 2) A blood pressure has been documented in iView.

HIGHLIGHTS

Outpatient vs Outpatient OB encounter type

- Outpatient OB encounter types will be for **pregnant patients** seen in the New Beginnings clinic, Fetal Monitoring clinic, Maternal Fetal Medicine clinic.

How does this affect my practice? What do I need to do next?

- If the patient is pre-pregnant, or postpartum in the above clinics, an outpatient encounter will be used (no need for the prenatal card).
- **Care providers:** if your current clinic encounter is an Outpatient OB encounter type and is not generating a prenatal card for this visit: ensure you have documented a blood pressure in iView, then click refresh when you return to your mpage of choice and a prenatal card should generate in the prenatal visits component
