

SCANING ID BANDS FOR SUNQUEST COLLECT

All locations using Sunquest Collect

HIGHLIGHTS

For all Group & Screen (pre-transfusion sample) collections:

- ▶ The patient should **wear** an **identification (ID) band**, *and*
- ▶ The **ID band is scanned** as per Sunquest Collect workflow, *and*
- ▶ Scanning is carried out on an ID band **worn by the patient**.
- ▶ **DO NOT** scan an **ID band remote from the patient**, i.e. on a WOW or outside the room.

What is new...What is the same?

- ID bands are a patient safety measure.

How does this affect my practice? What do I need to do next?

- If patient is not wearing an ID band, obtain or print a new one.
- Fasten the patient ID band to patient before scanning, as per policy.
- Scan the ID band worn by the patient before collecting all blood samples.
