




Steps for Donning (Putting On) Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)


REMOVE all personal belongings and leave outside room. Ensure hair is tied back properly.

OR














*Aerosol-Generating Medical Procedures (AGMP) examples include: nebulized therapy, CPR, CPAP, Endotracheal intubation & extubation, High frequency oscillatory ventilation, Bronchoscopy and bronchoalveolar lavage, Laryngoscopy, Positive pressure ventilation (BiPAP & CPAP), sputum.
