

## Transition from ePOPS to SHOP

<p><b>What's New?</b></p>	<p>On November 1<sup>st</sup>, clinical support documents on BC Children's and Women's ePOPS site will transition to the Shared Health Organizations Portal (SHOP).</p> <p>SHOP is the central access point for policies and decision support tools (guidelines, clinical procedures, protocols and standards) for Province Health Care (PHC), Provincial Health Services Authority (PHSA) and Vancouver Coastal Health (VHC)</p>
<p><b>Why?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Uses a "one-stop SHOP" approach for locating and accessing policies and decision support tools</li> <li>• Clinicians who work at multiple sites access the same SHOP portal to locate policies and decision supports tools using site-specific filters</li> </ul>
